LOGOS Bible Study Assistant – Be present and assist the Bible Study Teacher with any necessary tasks.


LOGOS Preschool Classroom Assistant - Be present and assist the Bible Study Teacher with any necessary tasks.

Pastoral Coverage

The following week the plan is that Pastor Erich will return to full days in the office, then the week of October 1st he will be fully back to ministry. Pastor Erich will be kept informed of any care needs and he will be available for Pastor Alex and Kelly Stahl as needed.

Pastor Erich should be walking around the first or second day after his surgery, and he should be discharged from the hospital by August 29th, so he will be available for pastoral care emergencies when Pastor Alex is out of town.
