Let's Talk About It - This Week in Our Children's and Youth Education:

Faith Village: We began a unit entitled, "Mary of Bethany Anoints Jesus". The story is found in John 12:1-8. Mary poured perfume on Jesus' feet to show her love for him. What can you do to show your love to Jesus?

LOGOS: <u>Preschool/Kindergarten</u>: They read the story of David and how he defeated Goliath (1 Samuel 16-17). This story was a great example of how God uses young and unlikely people to accomplish His work. During the story, they learned that King Saul gave David his helmet, armor, and sword, but being that he was still a boy, these items were too heavy for him. The children were then introduced to Matt Hines. Matt talked to the children about his turn-out gear and the resemblance of those pieces to life and how God gives us what we need to stay safe when we are "dressed for battle". <u>Second Grade</u>: They have been reading about Jesus' miracles and parables and then they acted out the story of Jesus feeding the five thousand. <u>Third Grade</u>: When Joshua met the Commander of the Lord's Army (Joshua 5:13), he was neither for the Israelites nor their enemies, he was on God's side. May we too be on God's side as we watch Him do the impossible.


