Mother's Room / Diaper Changing Station / Nursery Care



Children's and Large Print Bulletins are available on a table in the sanctuary narthex.


Hearing Assistance is provided by our system for hearing aids with a "t" switch position.



Sermon – "A Call for Unity in the Community" Scripture – 1 Corinthians 1:10-17

Paul's Letter

- Corinth a prosperous commercial crossroads, a major east-west trade route
- Originally a Greek city, then overtaken and ruled by Rome
- Paul founded the Christian community (Acts 18:1-11), stayed there 18 months
- Paul received a report of serious dissension within the community
- Written to a fledgling mission church, approximately five years old at the time

1 Corinthians 1

Verse 10 – fundamental theme of the letter; appealing for restoration, return to unity "that all of you agree with one another"

"that there may be no divisions among you"

"that you may be perfectly united in mind and thought"

Verse 13 – divided up and parceled out "Is Christ divided?"

Verse 17 – plain and simple gospel preaching, let the cross of Christ speak

"Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel"

"not with words of human wisdom"

"lest the cross of Christ be emptied of it power"
