

Prayer Joys, Concerns, Requests – Please Pray For:

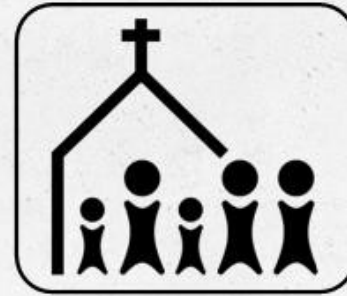
