

SCRIPTURE READING

Matthew 13:1-9 – That same day Jesus went out of the house and sat by the lake. ² Such large crowds gathered around him that he got into a boat and sat in it, while all the people stood on the shore. ³ Then he told them many things in parables, saying: "A farmer went out to sow his seed. ⁴ As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. ⁵ Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly, because the soil was shallow. ⁶ But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. ⁷ Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants. ⁸ Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop--a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown. ⁹ He who has ears, let him hear."

1 Thessalonians 1 - Paul, Silas and Timothy, To the church of the Thessalonians in God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ: Grace and peace to you. ² We always thank God for all of you, mentioning you in our prayers. ³ We continually remember before our God and Father your work produced by faith, your labor prompted by love, and your endurance inspired by hope in our Lord Jesus Christ. ⁴ For we know, brothers loved by God, that he has chosen you, ⁵ because our gospel came to you not simply with words, but also with power, with the Holy Spirit and with deep conviction. You know how we lived among you for your sake. ⁶ You became imitators of us and of the Lord; in spite of severe suffering, you welcomed the message with the joy given by the Holy Spirit. ⁷ And so you became a model to all the believers in Macedonia and Achaia. ⁸ The Lord's message rang out from you not only in Macedonia and Achaia--your faith in God has become known everywhere. Therefore, we do not need to say anything about it, ⁹ for they themselves report what kind of reception you gave us. They tell how you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God, ¹⁰ and to wait for his Son from heaven, whom he raised from the dead--Jesus, who rescues us from the coming wrath.

MISSION UPDATE: KAJIADO CHILDREN'S HOME

Prayer Requests from Hope for Kajiado (from Gaye List) in support of Kajiado Children's Home:

- Please pray for our new kitchen and cafeteria, and that our partnership with The Outreach Foundation continues to bless the children and meet their needs for a higher level of education. Please join us in seeking God's guidance on the continued impact our donors can make on making this a reality, as we raise money for classroom furnishings, a computer lab and library, as well as a modern kitchen to prepare food for the students.
- We have raised enough funds to build the school that is needed, but we're told that our current dining hall and kitchen are inadequate to feed the number of children that will attend our school, so we now need to raise additional funds for that. We have received four grants, but are still short \$175,000 needed to complete the project.
