

Nursery Care is offered during our 10:30AM service for children ages four months through preschool across from the church office. Parents can register children for Nursery Care online at www.stjohnsarchbold.org/nursery or by scanning the QR code to the left before checking into the nursery for the first time. We also have a Mother's Room located outside of the sanctuary for nursing mothers and/or mothers with young infants and toddlers. Diaper changing stations are located in

both the Mother's Room and the Nursery. An usher will gladly direct you if needed!

Children's Busy Bags are located in the sanctuary narthex for children ages one-year to third grade. Bags are marked by age (**Pink** = Ages 1-2; **Green** = Ages 3-5; **Yellow** = Grades K-3). Psalm 86:11-13 – Part of a prayer of David – Teach me your way, O Lord, and I will walk in your truth; give me an undivided heart, that I may fear your name. ¹² I will praise you, O Lord my God, with all my heart; I will glorify your name forever. ¹³ For great is your love toward me; you have delivered me from the depths of the grave.

- Through the work of the Holy Spirit, Paul has knowledge of God's will and purpose, enables Paul to pray with insight
- Paul has confidence through his faith in Christ Jesus
- Kneeling a position of humility, in prayer and in obedience before the Lord
 - Solomon (1 Kings 8:54), Ezra (Ezra 9:5), David (Psalm 95:6), Daniel (Daniel 6:10), Stephen (Acts 7:60), Peter (Acts 9:40), Paul (Acts 20:36)

¹⁵ from whom his whole family in heaven and on earth derives its name.

- The essential ideal of unity of the Body of Christ
- Paul knows God is Father of both Jew and Gentile

¹⁶ I pray that out of his glorious riches he may strengthen you with power through his Spirit in your inner being,

- A inner, spiritual strengthening with power through the Spirit of God
- There is a common need for both physical exercise and spiritual exercise
- Power from the glorious riches of God unfathomable
